Senior children can also bring their projects to school on Friday and these can be stored in the pool area. The children will need to get their project out of the pool area and take them to the display area for judging on Saturday.

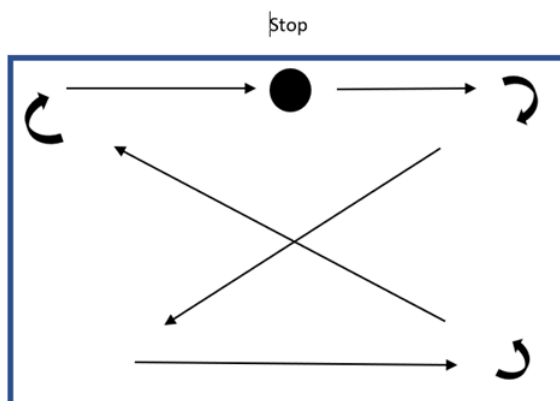
#### SATURDAY
